

Professor Emeritus Irfan Habib



Padma Shri Irfan Habib (born 1931) is an Indian historian of ancient and medieval India, following the approach of Marxist historiography. After he returned from Oxford he joined Aligarh Muslim University as a member of the faculty. He was Professor of History at Aligarh from 1969–91. He is presently appointed as Professor Emeritus at the Department of History of the AMU. He has authored a number of books, including Agrarian System of Mughal India, 1556–1707 and Medieval India: The Study of a Civilization. National Book Trust, 2008.
