Affiong L. Affiong is the CEO of Moyo Pan Afrikan Solidarity Centre with offices in Accra and London as well as a global Pan-African Organzier. The centre promotes awareness and disseminates knowledge about the rich heritage of African history, culture and art.



DR. IN MIREILLE NGOSSO

DR Congo / Austria
DOCTOR, POLITICIAN, ACTIVIST

Dr Mireille Ngosso is a Viennese doctor and politician who campaigns for social justice, integration and women's rights. Born in the DR Congo, she is committed to equal opportunities, inclusion and fair healthcare in the Vienna City Council. Her political work and her work as a doctor make her a leading voice for diversity and social inclusion in Austria.



AZIZ SALMONE FALL

Senegal / Egypt / Canada
POLITICIAN, ACTIVIST

Aziz Salmone Fall is a political scientist, member of GRILA and the Third World Forum and Coordinator of the international campaign 'Justice for Sankara'. He was actively involved against apartheid and today campaigns against foreign military bases in Africa, which is documented in the film Africom Go Home.



BIRAM DAH ABEID

Mauritania

Biram Dah Abeid is a Mauritanian politician and a committed Anti-slavery Activist. He is the founder and president of the anti-slavery movement IRA (Initiative pour la Résurgence du Mouvement Abolitionniste).



ELOI COLY

Senegal
KURATOR, AKTIVIST

Eloi Coly is the Chief Curator of the "House of Slaves" of Gorée, Senegal. This place calls for awareness of all forms of human rights violations and their harmful effects on human existence.



PRISCILLA HIRSCHHAUSEN

Ghana / Germany
TRAINER, SOCIAL ENTREPRENEUR, ACTIVIST

Priscilla Hirschhausen founded the association 'We Integrate' in Nürnberg and offers workshops on anti-racism and empowerment. Since the end of 2024, she has been supporting tailors in Ghana through the Kofaya project, helping them earn a fair income and market their products in Europe.

LANHOUÉ IMHOTEP SERGE BAYALA

Burkina Faso
HUMAN RIGHTS ACTIVIST, COMMUNITY-LEADER

Lanhoué Imhotep Serge Bayala is the Secretary General of the Pan-African movement 'Deux heures pour nous, Deux heures pour Kamita' (2H). The movement has addressed over 2,000 topics, held 160 conferences, and established branches in Burkina Faso, Ivory Coast, and South Africa. Bayala is committed to Africa's cultural and historical heritage.



PRINZ KUM'A NDUMBE III

Cameroon
HUMAN RIGHTS ACTIVIST, WRITER, CULTURAL HISTORIAN

Prinz Kum'a Ndumbe III, Founder of AfricaAvenir International, he is an internationally respected Pan-African scholar, prolific writer, and legitimate heir to Lock Priso, a prominent king of the Sawa in Cameroon. He has dedicated his life to the renaissance and reexamination of African cultures and history. In the 1980s, he founded AfricaAvenir as an independent African cultural center.



ISSOUFOU SARÉ

Burkina Faso
COMMUNICATIONS EXPERTE, CULTURE PROMOTER

Issoufou Saré is the General Director of Global Communication and the publisher of the leading television channel BFI in Burkina Faso. Under his leadership, BFI has become one of the most influential broadcasters in the country.



DR. DANIELLE SINGA MIMBANG

Cameroon / Italy
GYNECOLOGIST, ACTIVIST

Danielle SINGA Mimbang, originally from Cameroon, is a gynecologist in Milan, having specialized in infertility after studying at the University of Milan. She founded two associations, ASAF and Bougue, dedicated to promoting women and young people from sub-Saharan Africa. She is actively involved in women's health initiatives.



SENFON TONKAM

Cameroon / Allemagne
ANTI-RACISM EXPERT, ACTIVIST

Senfo Tonkam, a former Cameroonian student leader in exile in Germany, is a committed anti-racism and anti-imperialism activist. He founded "Maat Revolution" and "NubiaKemet", theories for the liberation and reconstruction of Africa. In Germany, he is involved in anti-racist movements and educational projects.

CULTURAL ACTIVIST, KAMITE WOMAN

We say IEEEM HOTEP, which means 'peace be with you'. Ngalula Mfuamba is a cultural activist and Kemetin, committed to the liberation of the black continent. As Secretary for Educational Affairs at the Communauté Kamite International (C.K.I.), she is committed to recognising the dignity of the black man worldwide.

Nigeria / Germany
ARTIST, AFRICAN CULTUR, WOMENS RIGHTS ACTIVIST

Dr. (Hon) Vivian Timothy is an award-winning Nigerian artist in Germany. Her art, shaped by African culture, addresses the beauty and challenges of Africa, with a focus on women, traditions, and socio-economic issues.



SMOCKEY

Burkina Faso
RAPPER, MUSIC PRODUZER, POLITICAL ACTIVIST

Smockey, born Serge Martin Bambara in Ouagadougou, founded the rap-specialised Studio Abazon in Burkina Faso in 2001. In 2013, he founded the Balai Citoyen democracy movement with Sams'K Le Jah. He uses his music to address political and social issues, particularly in relation to democracy and justice.



DIDER AWADI

Burkina Faso
RAPPER, MUSIC PRODUZER, POLITICAL ACTIVIST

Didier Awadi is a Senegalese rapper and co-founder of the group Positive Black Soul. As a political activist, he addresses social injustice and colonialism in his music, while promoting Pan-Africanism and the African youth movement.



KI'LUANDA

Congo / Angola / Germany
SINGER, GOSPEL, JAZZ, FUNK, R'N'B

Melanie Ibemba, alias Ki'Luanda, is a singer from Nuremberg with roots in Congo and Angola. With her mixture of soul, funk and jazz and her statement 'Black and Proud', she actively campaigns against racism and for change in music and society.



WASEEM

Germany / Egypt
RAPPER, ORGANISER, POLITICAL ACTIVIST

Achim 'Waseem' Seger is a German-Egyptian rapper, DJ, event organiser, social worker and activist. Whether as head of the specialist centre for youth work in the migration society, initiator of the multi-award-winning festival 'AusARTen' or on the board of 'Die Urbane. A Hip Hop Party' - Waseem combines art, culture and political commitment in the fields of hip hop, anti-racism and empowerment.



JIREH

Congo / Angola / Germany
RAPPER, ARTIST, COMMUNITY ORGANISER

Jiréh Emanuel, known as JIREH, is an artist, community organiser and art student in Munich who is committed to equality for Black people in the diaspora and Africa. As a board member of Morgen e.V. and AK Panafricanismus, he is actively committed to social justice. His commitment ranges from local to global level.
